Mathematics

Initially we will be following the Recovery Curriculum. We will assess the children to see where they are at. We will then support and develop their learning from this point ensuring they are secure before moving on.

We will follow the Year 1 Maths curriculum starting with a focus on number and place value. We will be working on counting objects, counting forwards and backwards, one more than, one less than, comparing and sorting numbers and objects, ordinal numbers, parts and wholes, addition facts, number bonds to 10, subtraction, fact families, comparing addition and subtraction statements, patterns, 2D and 3D shapes, tens and ones.

During our maths lessons, we will use a range of strategies such as concrete, pictorial and abstract methods to support our learning as this will really secure our knowledge and ensure the skills are fully embedded.

English

In Literacy this term, we will be focusing on "The Colour Monster" along with a wide range of other texts relating to our theme. We will work on simple sentence writing and structure as well as re reading our writing to check it makes sense. We will continue to work on our sounds identification and blending through our phonics lessons and in all other areas. We will build on our reading of common exception words. We will be listening to and discussing a wide range of stories, poems and non-fiction texts. We will work on re-telling familiar stories e.g. traditional tales and discuss their particular characteristics. We will incorporate the above elements into our writing activities while using a variety of texts to explore different genres. Spellings to be based on regular and common exception words and words relevant to our theme when necessary. We will continue to work on handwriting skills and correct letter formation.

Geography

Throughout our Geography lessons this term we will be exploring our school and its position in Wrenbury. We will be working on our map skills and learning how to follow routes on a map and use simple compass directions. We will look at various maps of Wrenbury and the surrounding towns and cities. We will explore aerial photographs again focusing on our school and the surrounding landmarks while also identifying other features. We will use these skills to draw our own aerial photographs of our school using simple features. **History**

In History we will discuss and explore changes that have occurred within living memory as well as events beyond living memory. We will look at the WW1 memorial and it's significance.

We will look at photos of our school through time and discuss as a class the changes that have occurred to our school as well as the surrounding features, landmarks and buildings. We will interview past pupils of Wrenbury that still have a connection to our school.

D&T

Exploring tools and their purpose safely. Building various structures and discussing how they can be made stronger, more stable,etc. Designing and building a car to get you to school.

Art

Self-Portraits and exploration of these using various materials and resources. Sketchings, drawing, paintings and craft work relating to our theme and those important to us.

Science

In Science this term, we will be exploring seasonal changes. Identifying seasonal and daily weather patterns in Wrenbury and the UK.

We will explore different types of simple questioning and begin to carry out simple tests.

We will be investigating everyday materials and their physical properties e.g. those that our school are made of and why these materials were used. We will be identifying, naming, comparing, grouping and describing the physical properties of different materials as well as explaining why these may be used/grouped together.

Music

As part of our lessons we will be exploring rhymes, nursery rhymes and songs relating to our theme. We will explore music and songs from the past and compare them to songs and music of today. We will experiment and learn to identify the different sounds of instruments and percussion instruments.

P.E.

In PE this term we will be concentrate on developing and enhancing our fitness levels and skills through a range of sporting activities. We will be working on our spatial awareness alongside throwing and catching skills, balance skills, agility and co-ordination.
