Mathematics

'People come in many shapes, sizes and colours. There are animals, too. They come in even more shapes, sizes and colours'

In mathematics in the Autumn term, Base 2 will be looking at composition of numbers. We will also be focusing on strategies for addition and subtraction with a strong understanding of number line. Children will also be learning the multiples of 10 up to 100 and Year 2 children will be looking at addition and subtraction with multiples of ten.

English

'Be patient, you'll learn how to use words soon enough.'
In Autumn Term, Base 2 are going to be looking at setting narratives and diary entries. In both of these genres, children will be enjoying, exploring and responding to a range of texts determining a purpose and audience. They will become familiar with text structures, language features moving onto planning and writing their own narratives and diary entries. Once children have drafted their writing, they will be begin to edit to improve.

Science

'You many not be able to speak yet either, even though your head is filled with questions.'

In science, Base 2 will be focusing on everyday materials and their properties and use. There will be a link between our school and the properties of materials in the school and their uses.


Design and Technology

RE
