Weekly Homework set on a Friday

There is an expectation that you always complete your homework fully and on time. The homework set will either prepare you for the following week's learning or recap the previous week's learning, and is therefore extremely important. Some weeks you may be given a creative homework and some you will be given English and Maths. You will be expected to practice your times tables, arithmetic and read daily. Homework club is available on a Tuesday lunchtime if you would prefer to complete the work set at school.

- Spellings, times table testing, and arithmetic will be tested on a Friday. It is expected that you practise the spellings given daily, at home. We are regularly working on the Year 5/ 6 spelling list in class- if you aren't given a specific spelling pattern or investigation it will be these that we are working on.
- It is also expected that you read daily and that this is recorded in your reading diary- these are checked every Friday and the children climb the reading ladder in class. Once at the top the children are rewarded with smilies and team points.

We will continue to work on our 'ACHIEVE' approach. It is really important that we recognise that getting something wrong is simply a step in learning and by the same token getting everything right means we have not learned anything new- we need a challenge!

Ask - always ask questions to further your learning

Concentrating- focus on your work and your task

Help-help others to learn

Improve- see your mistakes as an opportunity to learn.

Engage- engage yourself with your learning- take control of it

Value – value yourself; you are important and so are your classmates

Explore – explore your ideas and stretch your learning.

'ACHIEVE' awards are given out across school every Friday- these are really special and the children are very proud of them.
