- I would have liked a choice of dates during the summer term for visiting sessions, as the only session

available was a day I was working. Possibly a home visit type meeting before the start of term to discuss specific needs of my child.

- X comes home and sings the little songs he has been doing at bedtime. Really pleased he is interested in his letters which is down to school – thank you. Really pleased with the progress he is making and the care he receives.
- Extremely happy
- My daughter says every day it's great and awesome!
- Miss Pitchford and Mrs Griffin have been very nurturing towards X, especially with regard to his speech difficulties. I feel that at no point X has been upset or frustrated at not having been understood – thank you!
