### We All Matter Stars:

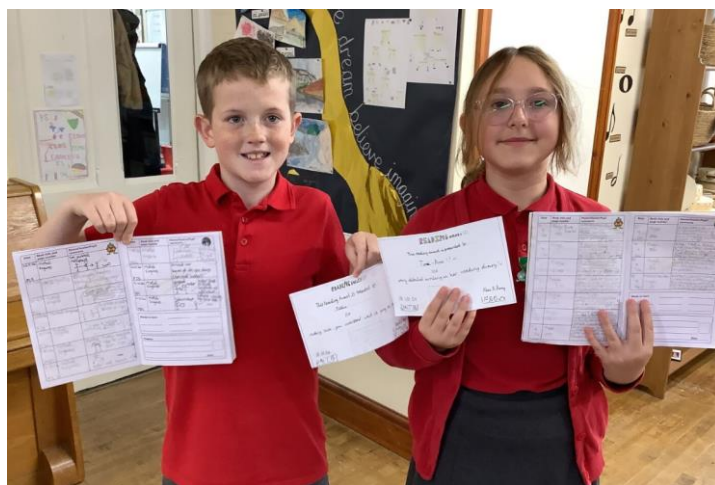
- Little Wrens:** Kaïden - for super tidying up.
