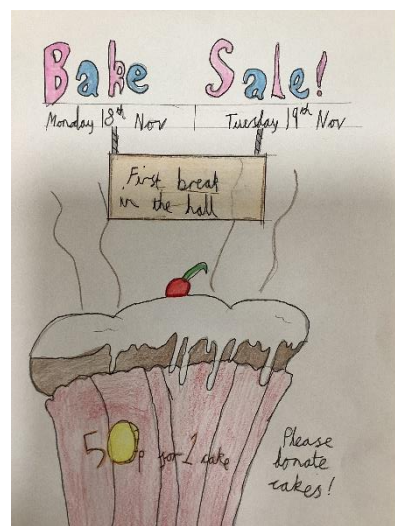


Base 5 Fundraising :
