Well, we have definitely entered March! In the words of Charles Dickens “It was one of those March days when the sun shines hot and the wind blows cold: when it is summer in the light, and winter in the shade.” We have definitely seen that mix this week, but it hasn’t stopped us from enjoying our week at Wrenbury. The children have spent lots of time outdoors, planting trees, learning in science and geography and enjoying time with friends at playtime. We have also been busy with sporting events this week with children enjoying ‘Games for All’ and a football tournament.



STEM Week:



This week each class explored different activities with a focus on STEM and the theme ‘Change and Adapt’. Mr Thorburn held a STEM assembly, focusing on changes of state. In the assembly we looked at reversible changes and irreversible changes – even looking at bread and toast! The children also explored decomposition of hydrogen peroxide, releasing oxygen and making a foam. Base 5 children have been using their light meters to gather and explore data. They will continue with this during the term. Our Little Wrens have been helping insects by creating bug homes in our forest area and everyone has enjoyed learning more about trains during our visit from the model railway. The children learnt how water is turned to steam and how this powered train engines.

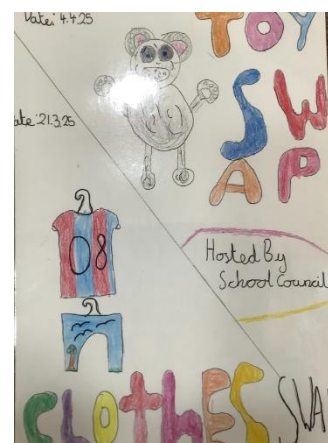


Last week, some of our footballers enjoyed a friendly match at Sound Primary School.
