## **School Roof Replacement - Important Information!**

Over the coming weeks and months, our school will be undergoing roof replacement work. This project has been carefully planned over the past year to ensure minimal disruption, though some changes to our usual routines will be necessary. These adjustments are crucial to ensure the safety of everyone involved and to help the project run smoothly.

### **Key Changes:**

- **No Access via Front Pedestrian Gates (POSTONED 1 WEEK):** Starting **Monday 31<sup>st</sup> March**, the pedestrian gates on the main road will be closed. All access to the school during drop-off and pick-ups will be via the MUGA gate only.
- **Access During the School Day:** If you need to access the school during school hours, you can do so through the school car park. One gate will remain open for this purpose. There will be no public access to the back gate (on the playground) during this time.
- **The Nest:** For morning sessions, all children should come to school via the MUGA gate. For afternoon pick-ups (after 4pm), please use the school car park.
- **After-School Clubs:** Please collect your child(ren) from the school via the car park at the end of after-school clubs.

Communication: Where possible, we kindly ask that you send messages to the school office via email or phone call to help us manage inquiries efficiently.

We appreciate your understanding and cooperation as we work to improve the school's facilities. If you have any questions or concerns, please don't hesitate to contact the school office.
