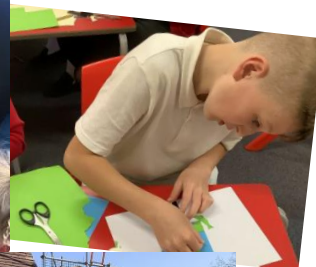


Wrenbury Primary School Newsletter
