My goodness, the weeks really do fly by—especially when they're only four days long!

This week, our Little Wrens have been learning all about recycling and reusing. They've been busy creating all sorts of wonderful things, but my favourite has to be the snail habitat made entirely from reusable materials—such imagination!

Base 1 have been diving into their book *Tickly Octopus* and discovering all sorts of fascinating facts about these amazing sea creatures. Base 2 have been getting creative too, starting with sketchbooks and drawing, which then led to a brilliant class sculpture—it's looking fantastic! Base 3 have also been exploring art, using their sketchbooks to experiment with marks and patterns before transferring those skills to work with clay.

Over in Base 4, the children have been eating various foods to see which teeth they use and described the function of these teeth. The children then identified that with an apple, our incisors are used to bite off chunks, and our molars are used to crush and to support digestion. Crusty bread required our canines to be used as it is a tougher piece of food to break off.

Base 5's Year 5 pupils have been combining their maths and computing skills—completing surveys and using programming to present their data. Meanwhile, our Year 6s have been working incredibly hard, staying focused during a week of revision ahead of their SATs next week. We're so proud of their dedication.

And beyond the classroom, we've been enjoying cricket and maypole dancing during lunchtimes. Many children have also been making the most of our forest area—planting, watering, and simply enjoying the calm and peaceful space.
