We've got an exciting few weeks ahead, packed with memorable events: Health and Wellbeing Week, Sports Day, Town Sports, Y6 transition days, in-school transition activities, school trips, the summer fair, and our final themed days. One of my highlights this week has been exploring the forest area, where we discovered ladybird larvae and caterpillars. It was fascinating to observe these tiny creatures up close, and we're all hoping to spot some butterflies and ladybirds soon. Our Little Wrens have also been busy planting out their sunflowers—how long before they're taller than the children, I wonder?



Across the school, the children have been diving into some brilliant learning. Base 1 have fully embraced their pirate theme, making flags, drawing treasure maps, and writing lively pirate rhymes. In Base 2, the children have been inspired by Michael Morpurgo's *The Flying Scotsman*, creating vivid descriptive writing and designing their own levers in DT to include in a model train. Meanwhile, Base 3 have been exploring Arctic animals and working on informative texts about their chosen creatures—I've even learned a thing or two about deep-sea squid thanks to their fantastic research!

Base 4 have moved on from angles to symmetry, using mirrors and shapes to create stunning reflective patterns. And to end the week, Base 5 enjoyed a wonderful trip. Base 5's charity is the National Trust and because their learning this term links Manchester and Liverpool, exploring the rise of both cities during the Industrial Revolution they visited Dunham Massey, near the Manchester, to learn about the lives of wealthy people from Manchester and their links with the Industrial Revolution.
